5 **ORDINANCE NO. 2964**

7 An ordinance amending Appendix A-Zoning, Part 4, Off-Street Automobile  
8 Parking & Loading Regulations, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to limit  
9 the sale of cars on private property.

10 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to limit the sale of cars on private  
11 property.  
12

13  
14 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it  
15 does hereby amend Appendix A-Zoning, Part 4, Off-Street Automobile Parking &  
16 Loading Regulations, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell as follows:  
17

18 Delete Section 4.105 in its entirety and replace with the following:  
19

20 "A. No person shall park any motor vehicle, trailer or watercraft upon any  
21 public or private property for the purpose of displaying such motor  
22 vehicle, trailer or watercraft for sale, hire or rental unless the property  
23 is duly zoned and permitted by the City for the transaction of that  
24 type of business upon such property. A motor vehicle, trailer or  
25 watercraft shall be presumed to be displayed for sale, hire or rental if  
26 a price, telephone number, contact person or address is displayed  
27 thereon.  
28

29 B. This section shall not prohibit any person from parking any motor  
30 vehicle, trailer or watercraft displayed for sale, hire or rental on  
31 private property provided that express permission from the property  
32 owner is prominently displayed on the motor vehicle, trailer or  
33 watercraft. No property owner shall give such permission more  
34 frequently than three (3) times per calendar year without having  
35 obtained a proper dealer's license.  
36

37 C. This section shall not prohibit any person from displaying for sale any  
38 personally owned motor vehicle when such display is incidental to  
39 such person's normal daily activities."




