ORDINANCE NO. 2971

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1606 to provide for a change in the uniform and equipment allowance for Slidell Police Department employees covered by the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1606 on April 12, 1983, providing for a Sixty Dollar (\$60.00) per month uniform and equipment allowance for Slidell Police Department employees covered by the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, there has been no change in the amount of said allowance since 1983; and

WHEREAS, the cost for maintaining Police Department uniforms has increased significantly since the adoption of the herein referenced ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Ordinance No. 1606 by increasing the monthly uniform and equipment allowance for Slidell Police Department employees covered by the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System from Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) per month to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2001.
