## **ORDINANCE NO. 2996**

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 11 Criminal Code, Section 11-190. Disturbing the peace, to provide for penalties for the commission of this crime during a parade.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell currently has an ordinance prescribing the crime of disturbing the peace and the penalty therefore; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council believes it is in the best interest of the City of Slidell to prescribe greater penalties for disturbing the peace during a parade so that the family atmosphere can be more readily maintained during City sanctioned parades.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Section 11-190 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell as follows:

Section 11-190. Disturbing the peace

Add a new subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c) Whoever commits the crime of disturbing the peace shall be fined Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) or imprisoned for a period not to exceed six (6) months or both, provided that such commission occurs within one hundred fifty feet (150') of a City of Slidell designated parade route and during the time and on the date for which any City sanctioned parade permit was issued."
