6 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
7 Chapter 28 Utilities, to amend public utility fees as requested by the City

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
11 does hereby amend its Code of Ordinances Chapter 28 Utilities as follows:

13 Sec. 28-29. Monthly rates for services; use of funds.

14 In paragraph (a) delete "\$14.88" and replace with "\$16.40" and delete
15 "\$18.60" and replace with "\$20.50".
16

17 In paragraph (b) delete the chart for residential and commercial in its entirety
18 and replace with the following:

21 "Residential:	
22 First 5,000 gallons	\$11.60
23 Thereafter, each 1,000 gallons	1.10
24 Commercial:	
25 First 5,000 gallons	12.70
26 Thereafter, each 1,000 gallons	1.10"

28 Sec. 28-34. Water rate for users outside the corporate limits.

29 In paragraph (a) amend the fees as follows:

31 In item (1) delete "\$24.80" and replace with "\$27.30".
32

33 In item (2) delete "\$24.80 and \$2.00" and replace with "\$27.30 and \$2.20".
34

35 In item (3) delete "\$37.20" and replace with "\$40.90".
36

37 In item (4) delete "\$37.20, plus \$2.05" and replace with "\$40.90, plus \$2.30".
38

39 Sec. 28-131. Sewer user charge.

40 In paragraph (c)(1) minimum charge, amend the fees as follows:

42 In item "a" delete "\$18.10" and replace with "\$19.90".
43

44 In item "b" delete the chart in its entirety and replace with the following:

46 "First 4,000 gallons	\$10.60
47 Each additional 1,000 gallons up to 20,000	2.00
48 Each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter	1.70"




