6 **ORDINANCE NO. 3013**

7  
8 An ordinance amending Chapter 11 to add a new section, Section 11-207,  
9 to provide for a prohibition against aggressive begging.

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that  
11 Chapter 11 is amended to add Section 11-207 to read as follows:  
12

13 **“Sec. 11-207. Aggressive begging.**

14 (a) *Aggressive begging prohibited.* No Person shall engage in aggressive  
15 begging in any public place in the City of Slidell, as those terms are  
16 defined in this section.  
17

18 (b) *Definitions.* As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall have the  
19 following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates that a different  
20 meaning is intended.  
21

22 (1) Aggressive begging: begging with intent to intimidate another  
23 person into giving money or goods.  
24

25 (2) Beg: Asking for money or goods as a gift, whether by words, bodily  
26 gestures, signs or other means.  
27

28 (3) Intimidate: Coercing or frightening into submission or obedience.  
29

30 (4) Public place: Any road, alley, lane, parking area, sidewalk or any  
31 place, private or otherwise, adopted to and fitted for vehicular or  
32 pedestrian travel, that is in common use by the public with the  
33 consent, expressed or implied, of the owner or owners, and further,  
34 any public playground, school grounds, recreation grounds, parks,  
35 parkways, park drives, park paths and wharves, station grounds  
36 and rights-of-way open to the use of the public.  
37

38 (c) *Penalty.* Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this  
39 ordinance shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars or




