ORDINANCE NO. 3017

An ordinance amending Chapter 28 Utilities, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, to update provisions in the chapter.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to update provisions in Chapter 28 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 28 Utilities as follows:

Sec. 28-25 is amended to provide for increased utility connection fees.

Sec. 28-25. Work done by city in making connections; fee.

Delete paragraph "(a)" in its entirety and replace with the following:

"(a) The water connection from the system to the property line shall be made by the City at the following rates.

8 upon submission of an application for a building permit or, if no
9 building permit is required, an application for sewer or water

16 connection. The City shall determine any such additional cost

28 “(a) If water service to a customer is scheduled to be
29 discontinued by the City due to nonpayment or late payment
30 of the water bill account, a service charge of \$15.00 shall be
31 charged to such customer.”

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35 Delete “Sec. 28-31. Reduction on prepared bills” as it is obsolete.

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37 Sec. 28-52 is amended to update required materials.

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39 **Sec. 28-52. Materials.**

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41 Delete subparagraph “(a)(2)” in its entirety and replace with the
42 following:

43 “(2) C-900 class 150 pvc for all sizes 4 inches and larger”.

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45 Delete paragraph “(c)” in its entirety and replace with the following:

46 “(c) Cast iron fittings shall be mechanical joint (MJ).”

15 Delete the second sentence in its entirety and replace with the
16 following:

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24 Sec. 28-130 is amended to provide penalties for violation.

25 **Sec. 28-130. Prohibitions and limitations on discharges into the**
26 **public sanitary sewerage system.**

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28 In subparagraph "(c)(2)" add a new subsection "(d)" as follows:

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30 "(d) (1) Any person who violates the provision of this
31 subsection shall be served with written notice stating the
32 nature of the violation and a time limit for the satisfactory
33 correction thereof.
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36 (2) Any person who shall continue any violation
37 beyond the time limit stated in the notice shall be
38 administratively fined not less than \$50.00 and not more than
39 \$500.00 per violation per day. Additionally, the Certificate of
40 Occupancy for the premises may be revoked until the violation
41 is corrected.
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44 (3) Any person who violates any provision of this
45 subsection may be charged for any costs incurred by the City
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4 in maintaining or repairing its wastewater treatment system
5 resulting from the violation.

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7 (4) Any person fined pursuant to this subsection shall,
8 within five days of the fine, be entitled to an informal
9 conference with the Director of Public Operations to ascertain
10 the appropriateness of the fine.
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13 (5) Appeals from the decision of the Director of
14 Public Operations shall be first to the City's Chief
15 Administrative Officer and then to the Slidell City Court.
16 Appeals to the Chief Administrative Officer must be taken
17 within five days of the Director's decision. Appeals to Slidell
18 City Court must be taken within ten days of the Chief
19 Administrative Officer's decision."




