ORDINANCE NO. 3029

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 3025, adopted September 11, 2001, to provide for technical corrections.

Ordinance No. 3025 is hereby amended as follows:

Page I, delete lines 17 through 27 and replace with the following:

"A City employee or City elected official who:

- Separates from City service after a minimum of ten (10) years of service;
 and
- 2. Within eighteen (18) months after such separation receives retirement benefits under any retirement plan authorized by the City; and
- Participated in the City's health insurance plan for a minimum of twelve
 (12) months immediately prior to such separation; and
- 4. Participates in the City's health insurance plan from the time of separation to the time retirement benefits are received;

may elect to continue to participate in the City's health insurance plan. The City shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the individual or family coverage elected by the former employee or elected official beginning at the time retirement benefits are received."
