8 An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 3025, adopted September 11,
9 2001, to provide for technical corrections.

10 Ordinance No. 3025 is hereby amended as follows:

12 Page I, delete lines 17 through 27 and replace with the following:

13 "A City employee or City elected official who:

- 14
15 1. Separates from City service after a minimum of ten (10) years of service;
16
17 and
18
19 2. Within eighteen (18) months after such separation receives retirement
20 benefits under any retirement plan authorized by the City; and
21
22 3. Participated in the City's health insurance plan for a minimum of twelve
23 (12) months immediately prior to such separation; and
24
25 4. Participates in the City's health insurance plan from the time of separation
26 to the time retirement benefits are received;
27

28 may elect to continue to participate in the City's health insurance plan. The City
29 shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the individual or family coverage
30 elected by the former employee or elected official beginning at the time retirement
31 benefits are received."


