13 **Sec. 6-31. Animal bite cases.**


14 Add a new paragraph (f) to read as follows:

16 “(f) Any domestic animal that is at large or has escaped from the confines of its
17 owner’s yard and has killed or has caused injury to another domestic animal shall be
18 quarantined for a period of ten (10) days at Slidell Animal Control or at a veterinarian clinic
19 at Slidell Animal Control’s discretion.”


