WHEREAS, the developer has posted a maintenance bond in the amount of \$72,100.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that:

- (1) The Slidell City Council hereby accepts for maintenance the streets, utilities, and drainage system of Kensington Estates Subdivision, Phase 1; and
- (2) The Slidell City Council hereby accepts Kensington Estates Subdivision, Phase 1, consisting of 43 lots, more fully shown on Survey Number 04060, dated Revised 3/3/04; and

(3) Any tree in excess of four inches in diameter that is removed from any lot and which is not within the building footprint, driveway or sidewalk, shall be replaced on a one-forone basis with a tree of at least two inches in diameter and eight feet in height.
