5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3301**

7 An ordinance permitting the temporary placement of travel trailers,
8 recreational vehicles and FEMA supplied housing, as approved by the City of Slidell
9 Planning Department, on private residential property for a period not to exceed twelve
10 (12) months.

11 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a provision in its zoning codes prohibiting
12 the use of trailers as living accommodations in residentially zoned areas; and
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14 WHEREAS, many citizens were victims of Hurricane Katrina, necessitating
15 the use of alternative housing facilities.
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17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
18 hereby waive the provisions of appendix A Zoning, Section 4.104 of the Code of
19 Ordinances of the City of Slidell to permit the temporary placement of travel trailers,
20 recreational vehicles and FEMA supplied housing, as approved by the City of Slidell
21 Planning Department, in residential property areas for victims of Hurricane Katrina, for a
22 maximum period of twelve (12) months.
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
27 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the waiver of the provisions of Appendix A
28 Zoning, Section 4.104 shall expire upon the determination by the City of Slidell's
29 Department of Building Safety that the residential structure upon the premises of which
30 travel trailers, recreational vehicles and FEMA supplied housing were placed is habitable.


4 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the twelve (12) month period specified in

6 City Council.
