9 WHEREAS, wooden pallets are a commodity subject to dramatic changes in  
10 price; and

12 WHEREAS, a mechanism to sell pallets is required to allow the City to obtain  
13 the highest price for the pallets.



15 BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that various  
16 wooden pallets as selected by the Administration are no longer needed by the City of  
17 Slidell for public use and are hereby declared surplus and shall be sold to the highest  
18 bidder; and



20 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that, prior to selling  
21 any wooden pallets, quotes shall be solicited by the City from at least two prospective  
22 buyers; and

24 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that this ordinance  
25 be published in the City's official journal three (3) times in fifteen (15) days; and

27 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that this ordinance  
28 shall be effective as of April 23, 2007.
