5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3653**

7 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
8 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
9 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
10 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as
11 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
12 obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2013.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
14 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax
15 of 26.83 mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of
16 Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the
17 calendar year 2012.

18
19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
20 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:

21 A tax of 4.99 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues
22 to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal
23 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013, as shown by the
24 budget for the year 2013, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by
25 Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 4.99 mills.

26 A tax of 2.42 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
27 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013. So
28 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November
29 2, 2004.
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4 A tax of 2.04 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
5
6 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013. So
7 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4,
8
9 1981.

10
11 A tax of 4.04 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in
12 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013. So authorized by the special taxpayer
13
14 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.

15
16 A tax of 4.04 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of
17 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013. So authorized by the special taxpayer
18
19 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.

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21 A tax of 1.99 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving
22 public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013. So authorized by the
23
24 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.



26 A tax of 3.69 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
27 interest and maturing bonds for the 2005 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the City
28
29 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2013, as authorized by a special election held November
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31 18, 1995, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,
32 Louisiana, passed on the 14th day of December, 2004.

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34 A tax of 3.62 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
35 interest and maturing bonds for the 2010 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,
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37 Louisiana, for the year 2013, as authorized by a special election held October 17, 2009,
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
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
