duly advertised public auction.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time, and place of sale are to be

subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions at a
time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who shall also establish
method of payment and other requirements for bidders including deadline for removal.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective upon
adoption.
