

8 Appendix A – Zoning, Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, by adding Section
9 2.2519 – Camellia Bush Requirement.

11 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
12 hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Appendix A- Zoning, Part 2.
13 Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Section 2.25 Protection of existing trees and
14 landscaping requirements by adding the following section:

17 Section 2.2519 Camellia Bush Requirement:

18
19 Installation of minimum of three (3) camellia bushes for the first five (5)
20 acres and minimum of two (2) camellia bushes for each acre over five (5)
21 acres. Any genus of the Camellia is acceptable. The camellia bush can be
22 planted in the perimeter, parking, or pedestrian planting zones, but shall be
23 planted in a prominent location visible from the public right-of-way or near a
24 main entrance.
