ORDINANCE NO. 3839

An ordinance establishing rules, regulations, and prohibition against smoking, the use of tobacco and/or tobacco products and/or vapor products in and/or on any building owned or operated by the City of Slidell or any vehicle owned or operated by the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, Section 2-7(a) of the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances presently grants authorization to the Mayor "...to establish and to promulgate rules and regulations regulating, restricting, or prohibiting smoking in municipal buildings and on municipal property, other than the police department and the city jail."; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-7(b) of the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances presently grants authorization to the Chief of Police "...to establish and to promulgate rules and regulations regulating, restricting, or prohibiting smoking in the police department, in the city jail, or in police department vehicles."; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-7(c) of the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances sets out "The violation of the rules and regulations of subsections (a) and (b) of this section shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$ 500.00 or thirty (30) days in jail, or both"; and

WHEREAS, City complies with all applicable federal, state, local regulations and evidence best practices regarding tobacco use and smoking in the workplace and to provide a work environment that promotes productivity and the well-being of its employees.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Police Chief desire to adopt Louisiana Revised Statute 40:1291 *et seq*, save subsections .1, .2, .23 and .24 and the penalties set out in LSA R.S. 40:1291.22(B), in addition hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Police Chief desire to prohibit smoking, use of tobacco and/or tobacco products and/or vapor products in any City owned or operated building or vehicle or equipment; and

WHEREAS, City Directors and Chief of Police may establish a designated smoking area(s) consistent with this Ordinance and State law and clearly marked as such.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby adopt Louisiana Revised Statute 40:1291 *et seq*, save subsections .1, .2, .23 and .24 and the penalties set out in subsection .22(B).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby establish that it is unlawful for any employee, former employee, customer, and/or visitor, to use tobacco or other tobacco products and/or smoke in any City building and within twenty-five feet of an entrance of a City building. It is also unlawful for any employee to use tobacco and/or other tobacco products and/or smoke in any vehicle or piece of equipment owned or operated by the City.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that a designated "smoking area" consistent with this Ordinance and State Law may be established by the Director of each department and by the Chief of Police for the Police Department and that

such designated area(s) shall be clearly marked as such. No such area will be established in or within twenty-five feet of an entrance to a building owned or operated by the City.
