## **ORDINANCE NO. 4078**

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2, Article III, Division 4, Section 2-157 (Chief of Police Compensation).

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell's Home Rule Charter, Article IV, Section 4-05.D provides that the Chief of Police's salary shall be established annually by ordinance through the budget process and that no ordinance changing the Chief's salary shall increase such salary by more than the average percentage of increase granted annually to all city employees; and

WHEREAS, the average percentage of increase in salary granted to all City employees, as proposed in the City's budget for the 2022-2023 fiscal year, is in excess of one and one half (1.5%) percent; and

WHEREAS, subject to the adoption of the 2022-2023 fiscal year budget reflecting an average percentage of increase in salary granted to all City employees equal to or in excess of one and one half (1.5%) percent, the Chief of Police will receive a one and one half (1.5%) percent salary increase.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that, upon adoption of the City's budget ordinance for the 2022-2023 fiscal year, and effective July 1, 2022, the salary of the Chief of Police shall be set at \$118,257.00, and that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2, Article III, Division 4, Section 2-157 be amended to reflect such change.
