ORDINANCE NO. 4181

An ordinance authorizing the City of Slidell's Human Resources Director to update job descriptions as may be required to comply with the U.S. Department of Labor's FLSA salary threshold changes for overtime exemption and to otherwise administer any changes with respect to same.

WHEREAS the City's Home Rule Charter (Sec. 7-08) requires Council approval for changes to any position classification plans; and

WHEREAS the City's Civil Service Rules (Rule 2.18) contemplate "job descriptions" and "minimum qualifications" as being part of a classification plan; and

WHEREAS recently, the U.S. Department of Labor issued a final rule raising the salary threshold for employees to be exempt from federal overtime requirements of the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA); and

WHEREAS the City requires the flexibility to update its job descriptions, as may be required from time to time, to comply with this or similar rules governing FLSA application, as may be enforceable, and to otherwise administer such changes; and

WHEREAS the Civil Service Board has approved granting the Human Resources Director the authority to make such changes and provide such administration.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the City's Human Resources Director is authorized to update job descriptions as may be required to comply with the U.S. Department of Labor's FLSA salary threshold changes for overtime exemption, or similar applicable rules, and to otherwise administer such changes.

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This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
