ORDINANCE NO. 4294

An ordinance to amend Section 2-33 of the City's Code of Ordinances to align it with the most recent expression of legislative intent in the City's Charter with respect to the layover period for proposed ordinances.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 4131, a number of changes were proposed to the City's Home Rule Charter;

WHEREAS, at the November 18, 2023, election, the city's electorate approved those proposed changes, including an amendment to Section 2-11 of the Charter to allow an ordinance to be considered for final passage once it has laid over at least seven (7) days from its publication, and only after a public hearing has been held on same;

WHEREAS, it is advisable to amend Section 2-33(k) of the City's Code of Ordinances to align its provisions with this Charter change, the change being the most recent expression of legislative intent on the matter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Section 2-33(k) of the City's Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows (additions underlined; deletions ~~struck through~~): :

Sec. 2-33. - Procedure for introduction and consideration of ordinances.

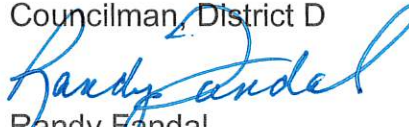
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- (k) Except for emergency ordinances, no ordinance shall be considered for final passage until it has laid over at least 744 days from its publication in full or by title only, and unless a public hearing has been held on the ordinance.
