RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of constructing and completing the 201 Facilities Plan for the collection and treatment of wastewater within the City and Parish of St. Tammany;

WHEREAS, the City is required to obtain servitudes and easements for the placement of the pipes along the collection routes;


WHEREAS, the City has been negotiating with the various landowners for the acquisition of this servitude;


WHEREAS, some of the owners have failed to agree to allow the City a servitude over which to place the pipes and collection lines; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to expropriate these properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Attorney be and he is hereby authorized to expropriate, in the name of the City, all properties necessary for the construction and completion of the 201 Facilities Plan for the collection and treatment of wastewater within the City of Slidell and the Parish of St. Tammany, including the Matulich property described in the lawsuit: City of Slidell v. Maude Carlisle Matulich, et al., 22nd Judicial District Court Number 70-740.
