WHEREAS, there are additional potential hazards caused by commercial traffic via rail and road, and


WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is dependent upon outside civil defense agencies, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the City of Slidell and its departments prepare a supplemental budget to provide necessary equipment to coordinate with those of the parish and other agencies with the intent to provide maximum protection of Slidell's citizenry and properties.
