located in Slidell, Louisiana, is a major intersection, and


WHEREAS, the traffic flow is extremely heavy at said intersection, and


WHEREAS, such heavy traffic causes congestion and possesses a danger

traffic light with a left turn arrow for the southbound lane of U.S. Highway 11
at its intersection with Gause Boulevard.

Secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
