

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in 1978 funded a resource recovery feasibility study through the Urban Grants Program (Phase I) to address the problems of solid waste disposal and the nation's energy shortage; and

WHEREAS, two phases of the feasibility study have been completed; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of a regional resource recovery facility located in eastern New Orleans for the purpose of electric generation appears to be technically and economically feasible; and


WHEREAS, further analysis of the facility is required to make a final decision on construction; and

WHEREAS, if it does not appear that implementation is in the best interests of the City, the City reserves the right to withdraw from the study; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, That the Council authorizes proceeding with Phase III of the Regional Solid Waste/Resource Recovery Study (Procurement).
