WHEREAS the Parish of St. Tammany is one of the fastest growing parishes in the State of Louisiana, and

WHEREAS much of this growth is occurring in the area of St. Tammany Parish immediately adjacent to the City of Slidell, and

WHEREAS such growth if not properly provided for can further compound the problems of the City and Parish in planning proper utility services, community planning and development standards, and the general provision of health, safety and public welfare, and

WHEREAS the Parish has adopted plans and development standards significantly different from the City's, and has not adopted building codes, and


WHEREAS the City of Slidell has established an Annexation Committee to address these problems of development and annexation,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that in order to minimize future problems caused by the application of different plans and standards and the lack of building codes in these areas of high growth, that the Parish Council is hereby requested to review its plans and standards and lack of codes to bring them into more conformity with the City's standards and codes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Parish Council review any proposed development in areas adjacent to the City for consistency with City plans.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the City Council and City Administration does express its wish and intention to join together and work with the Parish Council in seeking solutions to these growth related problems.
