WHEREAS the Slidell City Council has examined the Fiscal Year Budget for 1982-83 and has discovered excess revenues, and


WHEREAS the Slidell City Council wants to maintain and improve city services but also wants reasonable excesses to be transferred back to the citizens of Slidell, and


WHEREAS the May 11th, 1982 increase in the sanitation fee could have been absorbed by said revenue excess,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that this fee increase of sixty-five cents (\$.65) per household be eliminated effective July 1, 1983.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council shall continue to independently analyze the city finances as mandated by the Home Rule Charter of the City of Slidell.
