## RESOLUTION

A resolution approving and ratifying the execution of a Preliminary Agreement by and between the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority and Schwegmann Westside Expressway, Inc. granting preliminary authority for the issuance of not exceeding Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000) of industrial development revenue bonds by the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority for the purpose of financing a regional food market and warehouse as described in said preliminary agreement, and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the State Bond Commission, in connection with the issuance of bonds by the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (the "Authority"), requires, in order to place certain projects on its agenda, that (i) a public hearing be held by the Authority after public notice has been given fourteen (14) days in advance, (ii) a report be submitted to the local governing body, in particular the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana (the "City Council"), and (iii) that the City Council approve the issuance of bonds by a majority vote; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said rules and regulations, the Authority authorized the publication of a notice of public hearing which notice was published in the "Daily Times," in Slidell, Louisiana, in a manner sufficient to inform the public and potential competitors of the subject, date and place of such public hearing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of said notice, the Authority held a public hearing on October 5, 1982, at which no objections were raised by anyone present at the hearing and the Authority granted its approval for the execution of a Preliminary Agreement dated September 10, 1982 (the "Preliminary Agreement"), by and between the Authority and Schwegmann Westside Expressway, Inc. authorizing the issuance of not exceeding Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000) of revenue bonds (the "Bonds") to finance a regional food market and warehouse in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, this City Council has received a report from the Authority on the events that occurred at such public hearings; and

WHEREAS, this City Council desires, in accordance with the requirements of the State Bond Commission, to ratify and approve the Preliminary Agreement granting preliminary authority for the issuance of the Bonds and to approve the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal resession convened:

SECTION 1. That the Preliminary Agreement described in the preamble to this resolution is hereby approved and the execution and delivery thereof by the Authority is hereby approved and ratified.

SECTION 2. That the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority for the purpose of financing the Project described in the Preliminary Agreement is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That this City Council shall under no circumstances incur, be liable for or accept any financial obligation in connection with the issuance of the Bonds and that the Bonds shall never consititue an indebtedness or pledge of the general credit of the Authority, the City of Slidell or the State of Louisiana.

SECTION 4. That this application approved by the City Council is made provided convenants are contained in the Bond Sales' agreement restricting the use of proceeds to the regional food market and warehouse complex to be constructed on the site located at 1600 Gause Blvd. in the City of Slidell.

SECTION 5. That the Mayor is hereby authorized, to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
