RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is in dire need of additional commuter parking facilities; and

WHEREAS the Regional Planning Commission, in a recent study, has concurred with that need; and

WHEREAS the Slidell City Council at their December 28th, 1982 regular meeting appropriated \$50,000 toward that purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the Department of Transportation and Development is requested to review the Park-N-Ride facility as proposed in the Regional Planning Commission Study presented at the November 23rd, 1982 meeting of the RPC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Regional Planning Commission immediately seek funding for this project under the Federal 4-R Program.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of the resolution be sent to Secretary Paul Hardy, Governor David Treen, Representative Ed Scogin, Senator B.B. Rayburn, Congressman Bob Livingston, Senator Bennett Johnson, Senator Russell Long and the Regional Planning Commission.
