WHEREAS, the Greater Slidell Area Chamber of Commerce has obtained  
donations to plant the first four Camellia beds on City property, to be maintained  
by the City,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal  
session convened, that henceforth the City of Slidell shall be known as "THE  
CAMELLIA CITY".
