

PRESIDENTIAL DISASTER DECLARATION

REQUEST RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Slidell La. has been greatly affected by flooding, which occurred on April 7th and has declared a State of Emergency under Act 636, the Louisiana Disaster Act of 1974, and is utilizing its resources to the fullest extent, and

WHEREAS, the damages resulting from this disaster are of such severity and magnitude that certain areas of assistance are beyond the capabilities of Slidell, La., and

WHEREAS, these damages have been surveyed and are documented on the attached Disaster Documentation Report to show the severity of this disaster, and

WHEREAS, supplemental assistance by the State and/or the Federal Government is deemed necessary in order to relieve the suffering of the citizens and to restore the public facilities of Slidell, La,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT The Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, does hereby request the Governor of the State of Louisiana to provide such assistance or to petition the President of the United States to declare Slidell a major disaster area under the provisions of Public Law 93-288.
