

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the 1980 and 1983 spring rains caused considerable flooding
in the Slidell area, and

WHEREAS, at least some of this flooding was due to ground level
construction of Interstate Highway 10 and Interstate Highway 59 in the flooded
area,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Slidell City Council, in legal
session convened, that the Department of Transportation and Development and the
Federal Highway Administration is hereby requested to reassess the ground level
construction of Interstate Highways 10 and 59,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the St. Tammany Parish Council is hereby
requested to go on record requesting that said departments conduct a feasibility
study concerning additional openings underneath or the elevation of Interstate
Highways 10 and 59 in the areas effected by the recent flooding.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and
Development and the Federal Highway Administration are requested to institute
all possible measures to prevent the flooding of these areas through improvement of
the Federal Highway System to improve the drainage from area rivers.
