RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell did suffer water damage during the heavy rains of April 7th, 1983, and;

WHEREAS, surrounding communities in St. Tammany, Orleans, Jefferson and St. Bernard Parishes were also affected by these rains, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell was not flooded by the overflowing of the Pearl River, and;

WHEREAS, no subdivision in the corporate limits of the City of Slidell suffered damage from the overflowing of the Pearl River,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the media services, both local and national, are hereby urged to properly report what actually occurred within the corporate limits of the City of Slidell.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said media services correct the erroneous image, caused by faulty reporting, that the City of Slidell proper was heavily flooded due to high water from the Pearl River when in fact, the City of Slidell was not impacted by the Pearl River.
