22 session convened, that the media services, both local and national, are hereby
23 urged to properly report what actually occurred within the corporate limits of
24 the City of Slidell.

30 image, caused by faulty reporting, that the City of Slidell proper was heavily
31 flooded due to high water from the Pearl River when in fact, the City of Slidell
