RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell and the Parish of St. Tammany have experienced tremendous growth over the past ten years, and

WHEREAS, existing Interstate Highway 20 System is presently heavily burdened, and it is anticipated that normal growth of the population in the City of Slidell and the surrounding area of St. Tammany Parish demand that new access interchanges on I-10 be erected, and

WHEREAS, there is presently needed an interchange with appropriate access at Fremaux Avenue and Interstate 10 and that this interchange is presently under study by the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, Division of Highways, and

WHEREAS, the utilization of this interchange at Interstate Highway 10 and Fremaux Avenue will alleviate much of the present congestion of Louisiana 433 and Old Spanish Trail and Gause Blvd. and further would provide additional Hurricane Evacuation for the area thereby promoting the peace, harmony and safety of the citizens of Slidell and St. Tammany Parish and those visitors to the area:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the Slidell City Council is in favor of a new interchange at Fremaux Avenue

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Slidell City Council considers the Fremaux Interchange to be the primary goal of this city, but would have no objections to an additional interchange being constructed at Eden Isles Blvd. and Interstate Highway 10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that priority be given by all Federal, State, Parish and City agnecies and authorities to pursue and/or sanction construction and improvement of service roads parallel to I-10 in the Greater Slidell Area

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Slidell City Council hereby calls for a public hearing on this issue on April 26th, 1983.
