RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is anxious to see Fremaux Avenue (U.S.  
190 Business) improved, and;

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana has indicated its willingness to fund  
such improvements, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell also desires an interchange on said  
roadway, and;


WHEREAS, said interchange is considered a top priority by this City;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal  
session convened, that the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development  
is hereby requested to improve Fremaux Avenue by widening said roadway to three  
lanes from Front Street to the W-14 Canal and to four or five lanes from the  
canal to the interchange access points.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this City considers the interchange to be  
the most important project for the City and therefore urges the Louisiana Department  
of Transportation and Development to do whatever is necessary, after all appropriate  
studies of the entire roadway have been completed, to accomplish the construction  
of said interchange.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the  
Joint Legislative Subcommittee on Highway Planning and Construction, Representative  
Ed Scogin, Senator Elect Gerry Hinton, U.S. Senator Russell Long, U.S. Senator Bennett  
Johnston, U.S. Congressman Bob Livingston, and U.S. Secretary of Transportation  
Elizabeth Hanford Dole.
