WHEREAS February is traditionally Heart Month, and;

WHEREAS heart attacks and many accidents, such as drowning and electrocution, can cause instant clinical death, and;

WHEREAS Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), performed by a person certified in CPR, can reverse that condition and sustain life saving functions until trained medical assistance can be obtained, and;

WHEREAS North Shore Regional Medical Center is offering free classes in CPR each month, co-sponsored by the Slidell Jaycees and Jaycee Women, and a number of churches, civic organizations and companies, and;

WHEREAS in February, North Shore Regional Medical Center, with the cooperation of a number of commercial establishments, will engage in an extensive program to sign up as many persons as possible for these CPR classes, with a goal of at least one thousand signees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, does enthusiastically support this program and does urge all adult and teen-age citizens to "Sign Up to Be A Life Saver" in February and to learn CPR.
