WHEREAS, the termination of General Revenue Sharing would have a tremendous adverse impact on local government and the essential services it provides, and;

WHEREAS, President Reagan has previously declared that, "The Federal Government never spent money more wisely than by devoting it to general revenue sharing", and;

WHEREAS, this City Council wholeheartedly agrees with this sentiment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that President Reagan and Congress are hereby urged to retain General Revenue Sharing for all Municipalities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Congressional Delegation is hereby requested to firmly support the retention of General Revenue Sharing.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to President Ronald Reagan and the entire Louisiana Congressional Delegation.
