RESOLUTION R85-22

WHEREAS, on March 11, 1985 Mayor Alvin D. Singletary issued instructions to the city's permit department not to enforce Ordinance Number 1490, a sign ordinance, for the time being, and;

WHEREAS, such instructions gave a confused message to business owners, citizens and the general public of the city of Slidell as to the intent of the sign ordinance, and;

WHEREAS, only the Slidell City Council can suspend, amend or revoke any ordinance of the City of Slidell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Mayor Alvin D. Singletary is hereby instructed to immediately reinstate the enforcement of Ordinance Number 1490, a sign ordinance, except for removal of signs from private property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this council goes on record in reiterating its position that neither the Mayor nor any administrative official has the power to suspend or cause the nonenforcement of any city ordinance.
