SECTION 1. The sale, in accordance with the provisions of law, of not to exceed the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$478.000) Water Certificates of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the certificates having been authorized in accordance with the provisions of Title 33, Sections 3822 to 3835, inclusive, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be dated June 15, 1985, to be in the denomination of \$5,000 and \$2,800, in fully registered form, to bear interest due June 15, 1986 and annually thereafter at a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum(12%) per annum and mature serially on June 15 of each year as follows:

Certificates maturing in 1987 and thereafter are subject to redemption prior to their maturity, as a whole or in part, in inverse order of maturity, or by lot if less than a full maturity, on June 15, 1986 and on any interest payment date thereafter, at a price of 104% of the principal amount thereof plus accrued interest to the date of redemption.

The certificates are payable from the irrevocable dedication and pledge of funds derived from the levying and collection of a local or special assessment on each lot or parcel of real estate abutting the improved property.

All certificates of the same maturity must bear interest from the date thereof until paid at one basic rate of interest to be designated by the bidder, not exceeding twelve (12%) per centum per annum, and the certificates will be numbered serially.

Bids will be received in open and public session of the City Council at the City Hall, Slidell, Louisiana, on May 28, 1985, at 6:30 o'clock p.m.

SECTION 3. The right is reserved to sell the said certificates at any interest rate not exceeding Twelve (12%) per cent, to waive informalities and to reject all bids.
