16 A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be
17 held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, to authorize the
18 rededication and use of the revenues derived from the one percent (1%)
19 sales and use tax heretofore levied and now being collected therein,
20 making application therewith and providing for other matters in
21 connection therewith.

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, acting as the
25 governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana:
26

27 SECTION I. That, subject to the approval of the State Bond
28 Commission and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 29
30 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, the applicable
31 provisions of Chapters 5, 6 and 6-A of Title 18 and Sub-Part F, Part
32 III, Chapter 4, Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as
33 amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, a special
34 election to be and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in
35 the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), on SATURDAY,
36 MAY 3, 1986, between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m., and eight
37 o'clock (8:00) p.m., in compliance with the provisions of Section 541
38 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 (R.S. 18:541),
39 and that at the said election there shall be submitted to all
40 registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at the said election
41 under the Constitution and Laws of this State and the Constitution of
42 the United States, the following proposition, to-wit:

58 PROPOSITION TO REDEDICATE
59 EXISTING SALES AND USE TAX

61 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisi-
62 ana be authorized to fund into bonds the pro-
63 ceeds of the existing one percent (1%) sales
64 and use tax levied by virtue of an election
65 held on Tuesday, November 27, 1962, for the
66 purpose of constructing, acquiring or im-
67 proving lands, buildings or other works of
68 public improvements for said City, including
69 equipment and furnishings therefor, title to
70 which shall be in the public, for providing
71 a reserve for said bonds and for paying the
72 costs of issuance therefor, said bonds to
73 mature over a term not exceeding twenty-five
74 (25) years from date thereof, to bear in-
75 terest at a rate or rates of interest not

11 exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per annum
12 and to be issued in accordance with the pro-
13 visions and subject to the limitations of
14 Sub-Part F, Part III, Chapter 4, Title 39 of
15 the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 and

17 supplemental thereto, and shall the remain-
18 der of the avails or proceeds of said tax
19 in an amount up to one-half of the total
20 avails or proceeds of said tax be expended
21 as appropriated by the governing authority
22 of said City with the remainder of the
23 avails or proceeds of said tax, if any,
24 being dedicated and used for constructing,
25 acquiring or improving the above described
26 capital improvements for said City, title to
27 which shall be in the public?

29 SECTION II. That there shall be published in "The Slidell
30 Daily Times," a daily newspaper of general circulation within the
31 City, published in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and being the
32 official journal of this City, once a week for four consecutive
33 weeks, with the first publication to be made not less than forty-
34 five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date
35 fixed for election, notice of said election, which notice shall be
36 substantially in accordance with the Notice of Special Election
37 annexed hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference
38 the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

49 SECTION III. That this City Council, acting as the governing
50 authority of the City, shall meet at their regular meeting place,
51 the Slidell City Council Chambers, City Hall, 2055 Second Street,
52 Slidell, Louisiana, on TUESDAY, MAY 13, 1986, at SIX-THIRTY (6:30)
53 O'CLOCK P.M., and shall then and there in open and public session
54 proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of
55 the said special election.

63 SECTION IV. That the polling places set forth in the aforesaid
64 Notice of Special Election and situated within the corporate limits
65 of the City be and the same are hereby designated as the polling places
66 at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge
67 and Commissioners, respectively, shall be those persons designated
68 according to law.


10 SECTION V. That the officers designated to serve as
11 Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section IV
12 hereof, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and desig-
13 nated in compliance with Section 1287 of Title 18 of the Louisiana
14 Revised Statutes of 1950 (R.S. 18:1287) shall hold the said special
15 election as herein provided, and shall make due returns of said
16 election for the meeting of the City Council to be held on May 13,
17 1986. All registered voters in the City are entitled to vote at
18 said special election and voting machines shall be used thereat.

28 SECTION VI. That the Clerk of the Council be and she is
29 hereby empowered, authorized and directed to arrange for and to
30 furnish to said election officers in ample time for the holding of
31 said election the necessary equipment, forms and other paraphernalia
32 essential to the proper holding of said election.

38 SECTION VII. That certified copies of this resolution shall
39 be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Commissioner of Elections,
40 the Clerk of Court and Ex-Officio Parish Custodian of Voting Machines
41 in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and the
42 Registrar of Voters in and for said Parish, as notification of the
43 special election herein called in order that each may prepare for said
44 election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

52 SECTION VIII. That application be and the same is hereby
53 formally made to the State Bond Commission for consent and authority
54 to hold the aforesaid special election as herein provided, and in
55 event the aforesaid Proposition is carried, for consent and authority
56 to rededicate and use the revenues derived from the tax heretofore
57 levied and now being collected in said City; and that a certified copy
58 of this resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission
59 on behalf of this City Council, together with a letter requesting the
60 prompt consideration and approval of this application.

13 Pursuant to the provisions of a resolution adopted on
14 February 25, 1986 by the Slidell City Council, acting as the
15 governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana,
16 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held in
17 the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City") on Saturday,
18 May 3, 1986, at which election there will be submitted the fol-
19 lowing proposition, to-wit:

24 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana
25 be authorized to fund into bonds the proceeds
26 of the existing one percent (1%) sales and
27 use tax levied by virtue of an election held
28 on Tuesday, November 27, 1962, for the pur-
29 pose of constructing, acquiring or improving
30 lands, buildings or other works of public
31 improvement for said City, including equip-
32 ment and furnishings therefor, title to which
33 shall be in the public, for providing a
34 reserve for said bonds and for paying the
35 costs of issuance therefor, said bonds to
36 mature over a term not exceeding twenty-five
37 (25) years from date thereof, to bear in-
38 terest at a rate or rates of interest not
39 exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per annum
40 and to be issued in accordance with the pro-
41 visions and subject to the limitations of
42 Sub-Part F, Part III, Chapter 4, Title 39 of
43 the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 and
44 other constitutional and statutory authority
45 supplemental thereto, and shall the re-
46 mainder of the avails or proceeds of said
47 tax in an amount up to one-half of the total
48 avails or proceeds of said tax be expended
49 as appropriated by the governing authority
50 of said City with the remainder of the
51 avails or proceeds of said tax, if any,
52 being dedicated and used for constructing,
53 acquiring or improving the above described
54 capital improvements for said City, title to
55 which shall be in the public?
56

57 The said special election will be held at the following
58 polling places situated within the corporate limits of the City,
59 which polls will open at six (6:00) o'clock a.m., and close at
60 eight (8:00) o'clock p.m., in compliance with the provisions of
61 Section 541 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950

46 officers appointed to hold the said election, as provided in this
47 Notice of Special Election, or such substitutes therefore as may be
48 selected and designated in compliance with Section 1287 of Title 18 of
49 the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 (R.S. 18:1287) will make due
50 returns of such election to the City Council, and NOTICE IS HEREBY
51 FURTHER GIVEN that said City Council will meet at its regular meeting
52 place, the Slidell City Council Chambers, City Hall, 2055 Second
53 Street, Slidell, Louisiana, on Tuesday, May 13, 1986, at six-thirty
54 (6:30) o'clock p.m., and will then and there in open and public
55 session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the
56 result of said special election. All registered voters in the City
57 are entitled to vote at the said special election, and voting machines
58 will be used thereat.
