A resolution to provide for the authority of the Mayor to execute, and for the City to enter into an agreement by the City of Slidell of the Agreement for a Group Self Insurance Fund for Municipal Liability Risk Sharing dated effective January 1, 1981, Agreement for a Group Self Insurance Fund for Workmen's Compensation and Employer Liability Risk Sharing dated September 20, 1979, and the Agreement for a Group Self Insurance Fund for Accident and Health Risk Sharing dated effective February 1, 1983 to allow the pooling by interlocal risk management agencies of excess funds with excess funds of the same Agency and/or of other interlocal risk management agencies to establish a special loss reserve fund for the purpose or reinsuring all or any part of the excess insurance amounts otherwise required by Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1349 (A), (B) and (D) and to provide for better management of the Agency by the Trustees; to provide for amendment of such Agreements as may hereafter be required or requested by the Louisiana Commissioner of Insurance; to authorize the Mayor to contract with one or more other municipalities in order to amend such Agreements; and to otherwise provide with respect thereto.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1338-1347, as amended, authorizes two (2) or more municipalities to establish an interlocal risk management agency with respect to certain risk sharing, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell participated in the establishment of the interlocal risk management agencies known as the Louisiana Risk Management Agency II (hereinafter referred to as the "Agencies"), and;

WHEREAS, the Agencies have established certain funds to share the risk in the administration of accident and health coverage protection, municipal liability risk sharing, workmen's compensation and employer liability risk sharing, administration of claims, and;

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1349 (E) provides that interlocal risk management agencies may pool excess funds with excess funds of other interlocal risk management agencies to establish a special loss reserve fund for the purpose of reinsuring all or any part of excess insurance amounts required by Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1349 (A), (B) and (D), and;

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the City of Slidell to amend the Agreements to allow the respective Agencies to pool excess funds to establish a special loss reserve fund for the purpose of reinsuring all or any part of excess insurance amounts required by Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1349 (A), (B) and (D) and to provide for better management of the Agency by the Trustees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the City of Slidell through its Mayor, and with the attestation of the Clerk of the Council, is authorized to contract with one or more other municipalities in the State of Louisiana to amend the Agreement for a Group Self Insurance Fund for Accident and Health Risk Sharing dated effective February 1, 1983, Agreement for a Group Self Insurance Fund for Workmen's Compensation and Employer Liability Risk Sharing dated September 20, 1979, and to amend the Agreement for a Group Self Insurance Fund for Municipal Liability Risk Sharing dated effective January 1, 1981 to add to paragraph 10 of each agreement the following:

- To pool any excess funds of any Fund with "(e) excess funds of another interlocal risk management agency and to use such pooled excess funds to establish a special loss reserve fund for the purpose of reinsuring all or any part of the excess insurance amounts otherwise required by Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1349 (A), (B) and (D) as authorized by Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1349 (E).
- (f) Such uses and purposes as the Trustees in their sole discretion shall deem in the best interest of the Fund or the Agency.'

And to amend each Agreement to add a paragraph 12.1 to read as follows:

> "12.1 This Agreement shall hereafter be deemed automatically amended by the parties hereto to contain such terms and conditions as may be required or requested by the Louisiana Commissioner of Insurance."

to allow each respective interlocal risk management agency to pool funds to establish a special loss reserve fund, which if amendments shall be in substantially the form and substance as attached hereto as Exhibits A and B.
