WHEREAS, the property owners and businesses along U.S.

Highway 190 West, the portion of which is being proposed for annexation into the City of Slidell in conjunction with the City acceptance
of an annexation petition from Homart Corp., have expressed concern
with regard to the immediate need for relief from the traffic congestion that has resulted from the rapid growth in that area, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell shares this same concern and has previously expressed to the State of Louisiana the need for additional turn lanes and traffic signaling along this corridor, and;

WHEREAS, with the successful incorporation of this property into the city, Slidell recognizes its responsibility to move by whatever means it is capable to provide relief of this acute traffic problem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the City of Slidell go on record in support of providing traffic relief to this highway as the most important State project for the City of Slidell after the Fremaux Avenue project has commenced.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State be requested to provide temporary turn lane relief at the major traffic congestion areas in order to facilitate traffic flow while this project is being prepared for implementation.
