WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council strongly believes that learning and education are the only real long term solutions to the crises facing Louisiana, and;

WHEREAS, for this reason, the Slidell City Council believes the Legislature of the State of Louisiana should adhere to the provisions of Act No. 949 of 1985, wherein the act dedicates exclusively to education all funds in excess of \$100 million to be received by the State of Louisiana from any "8 (g) Offshore Settlement" with the Federal government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the State Legislature be requested to increase and enhance present state expenditures for education with this 8g money and not simply replace funds which maintain the existing education spending level.
