A resolution urging the voters of Slidell to support the City's Sales and Use Tax Rededication.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has agreed with Homart Corporation to annex North Shore Square and purchase the water and sewer treat-ment facilities at that site, and;

WHEREAS, the least expensive way to pay the annual debt costs for this purchase is to issue sales tax revenue bonds, and;

WHEREAS, state law requires that sales tax revenues be specifically pledged for debt redemption if sales tax revenue bonds are used.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the voters of the City of Slidell be urged to go to the polls on Saturday, May 3, 1986 and authorize the rededication of sales tax revenues to support a bond issue, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the voters be informed that a "yes" vote will not increase taxes and, in fact, will permit the lowest annual repayment schedule of any debt repayment method available to the city.
