RESOLUTION R86-46

A resolution accepting the Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report, dated July 22, 1986 (titled "Engineering and Feasibility Report 1% Sales Tax Election, September 27, 1986"), prepared by the Engineering and Finance Departments of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, relating to the Capital Outlay Program of the City and a proposed tax and bond election to finance capital improvements in connection therewith, ordering the filing thereof and providing for publication of a summary of such Report in the official journal of the City as required by Section 5-09 of the City Charter.

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Finance Departments of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, have prepared and submitted to this Slidell City Council an Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report, dated July 22, 1986 (titled "Engineering and Feasibility Report 1% Sales Tax Election, September 27, 1986"), relating to the Capital Outlay Program of the City, which Program contemplates the incurring of bonded indebtedness by the City to finance capital improvements in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, this Slidell City Council desires to accept said Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report; and

WHEREAS, Section 5-09 of the City Charter requires that a summary of such Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report shall be published in the official journal of the City at least sixty (60) days prior to the date of the election called for the purpose of incurring bonded debt;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council (the "City Council"), acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana:

SECTION 1. That this City Council has received and does hereby accept the Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report, dated July 22, 1986 (titled "Engineering and Feasibility Report 1% Sales Tax Election, September 27, 1986"), prepared by the Engineering and Finance Departments of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, relating to the Capital Outlay Program of the City.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby ordered and directed that copies of said Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report be filed in the offices of the Mayor and of the City Council to be available for public review during regular office hours.

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SECTION 3. That a summary of the aforesaid Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report shall be published in the official journal of this City and that an appropriate introductory notice shall be published therewith indicating that the summary of such Report is being published in compliance with Section 5-09 of the City Charter, said notice to be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Slidell proposes a Capital Outlay Program and contemplates the issuance of bonds of the City to finance certain capital improvements in connection therewith. In compliance with Section 5-09 of the City Charter, the Slidell City Council adopted a resolution on July 22, 1986, accepting the Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report prepared by the Engineering and Finance Departments of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, dated July 22, 1986 (titled "Engineering and Feasibility Report 1% Sales Tax Election, September 27, 1986"), which was prepared relative to the Capital Outlay Program and a proposed tax and bond election, and providing for the filing and publication of such Report as required by the City Charter. Copies of said Report may be reviewed during regular office hours at the City Hall in the offices of the Mayor and of the Slidell City A summary of said Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report (without exhibits which are on file with the complete Report and may be reviewed at the above named offices) is now published in compliance with Section 5-09 of the City Charter as follows:
