15 A resolution opposing the creation of a permanent land-  
16 fill site in the center of the City of Slidell.

17  
18 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a severe problem with  
19  
20 creosote pollution, and;


21  
22 WHEREAS, the polluted area, which is included on the  
23  
24 Superfund List for prompt dissolution, should be dispersed, and;

25  
26 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency proposed  
27  
28 solution is not to disperse, breakdown or destroy the pollutant,  
29  
30 but to confine it in a landfill site of five acres in the center of  
31  
32 the city, and;

33  
34 WHEREAS, this site will be dangerous and unusable, and  
35  
36 after a period of time again pose a threat to the well-being of  
37  
38 Slidell's residents.

39  
40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City  
41  
42 Council go on record as urging the Environmental Protection Agency  
43  
44 to adopt a solution to this pollution problem that will either  
45  
46 neutralize the pollutants, or transport them to a site that will  
47  
48 not endanger the public or deprive the city of an area potentially  
49  
50 well suited for effective development or purposeful use.
