27 shuttle fuel tanks at the Michoud Aerospace facility, and;

32 and laboratory modules for the space station, and;

36 WHEREAS, award of the contract to Martin Marietta would
37 be of inestimable value in assisting the economic recovery of the
38 south Louisiana area.

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council
43 that the city's support for creation of a space station and production
44 of the station's components by Martin Marietta be transmitted to
45 Congress and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, and;

50 be forwarded also to Mr. Richard M. Davis, President, Michoud
51 Aerospace, as evidence of this city's support for the space station
