14 WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany has created several
15 road districts which include parts of the corporate limits of the
16 City of Slidell; and

19 WHEREAS, these road districts have been structured in such
20 a way that City property owners have a minority voting power in each
21 district; and

24 WHEREAS, City property owners pay taxes to the City for
25 street maintenance and taxes to the Parish for Road District 14; and



28 WHEREAS, this Council believes that the establishment of
29 sub-road districts overlapping the boundaries of the City of Slidell
30 results in double taxation of City property owners; and

33 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell cannot by law file suit against
34 the Police Jury on these questions in its own name; and

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council
38 that the Mayor and the Council President, jointly, and without further
39 authorization from this Council, may direct the City Attorney to take
40 legal actions necessary on behalf of the property owners to halt the
41 establishment and taxation of City property owners through sub-road
42 districts.

45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Slidell agrees to
46 indemnify the named plaintiffs in any lawsuit filed in connection
47 with this matter by the City Attorney and hold them harmless from
48 any expenses whatsoever.
