WHEREAS, after nationally field-testing the program, NHTSA allocated funds to highway safety commission including the Louisiana Highway Safety Commission for implementation of the program in pilot cities within selected states; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Highway Safety Commission, after arranging for funding, selected the City of Slidell as the pilot city in Louisiana.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that authorization is hereby given the Slidell Police Department to implement The Alcoholic Beverage Vendor/Server Training Program in the City of Slidell on a pilot program basis beginning October 1, 1986 and ending September 30, 1987.
