WHEREAS, all citizens of our area benefit from these state-mandated services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council supports Proposition No. 2 rededicating the present 5:33 Mill Parish tax for use in funding state-mandated costs.
