30 denied Beta Sigma Phi an opportunity to choose a date for their

35 WHEREAS, allowing this sorority the third choice of date
36 selection at present will result in disrupting the entire ball and
37 parade schedule; and

41 WHEREAS, Beta Sigma Phi Sorority has agreed to relinquish
42 their position in date selection so as not to disturb the ball and
43 parade schedule as set by the Mayor's Executive Order, if the Mayor
44 and City Council agree to waive auditorium use fees for their or-
